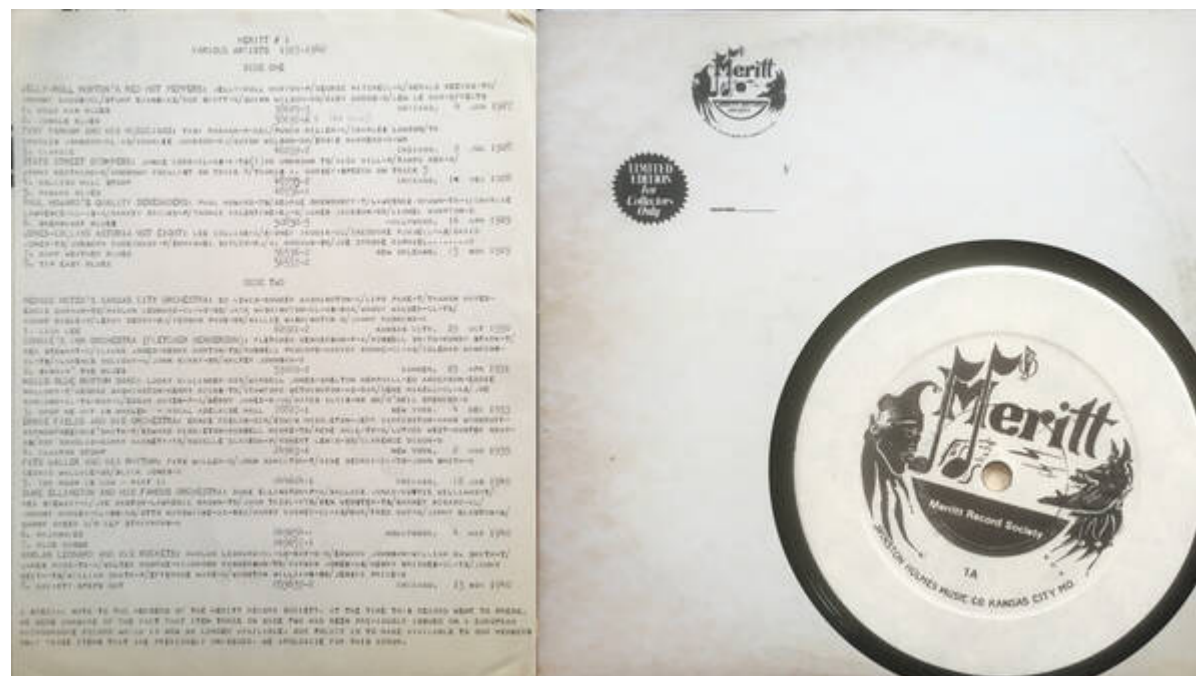

Jazz echo of the month (CEMJazz collections)

August 2025 "Wild Man Blues" Jelly Roll Morton's Red Hot Peppers. 33rpm 12", Meritt #1, USA, 1979.

First release in a series of "early jazz" compilations published from 1979 by the label "Meritt Record Society"; the sleeve is almost entirely white, the labels are minimalist (no text) and the titles are listed on a separate sheet. These records were available only by mail order to members of the Meritt

Record Society.



Track A1, **“Wild Man Blues”**, was recorded in Chicago on June 4, 1927 featuring Stump Evans (as), Quinn Wilson (brass b), Johnny Dodds (cl), George Mitchell ct), Baby Dodds (dms), Lew Le Mar (effects), Bud Scott (g), Jelly-Roll Morton (p), Gerald Reeves (tb).
